RCW 87.76.010 Coordination of programs—Reports. The directors of the several irrigation districts in the state shall take such action as they deem necessary to effect coordination of their common programs for the economical and efficient operation of their districts and the reclamation of lands therein, and prepare reports annually for such operations. [1947 c 193 ? 1; Rem. Supp. 1947 ? 7505-10.]

RCW 87.76.020 Coordinating agency—Expense, how defrayed. The directors of such irrigation districts may designate a state-wide association dedicated to the promotion of irrigated agriculture as a coordinating agency in the execution of the duties imposed by this chapter, and pay dues or assessments, or both, to the association from district expense funds, and the several districts may levy assessments against the lands therein for this purpose. Such dues and assessments shall be paid only on vouchers approved by the board of directors of the contributing district in the manner provided for the approval of district vouchers generally. The total of such voucher claims for any district in any calendar year shall not exceed two percent of the total amount or its equivalent of the expense fund levy of the district for that year. CHAPTER 87.76 RCW

RCW 87.76.030 General powers of directors. The board of directors of the several districts may effect the state organization herein contemplated and take such further and other action in behalf of their respective districts as they deem necessary to carry out the intent of this chapter, including support of and attendance at such meetings as may be required to promote and perfect the organization and to effect its purposes. [1947 c 193 ? 3; Rem. Supp. 1947 ? 7505-12.]

RCW 87.76.040 Cooperation with other agencies authorized—Financial contributions—Contracts with public and private agencies. To avoid duplication of effort the state association may, in the discretion of its officers, affiliate and cooperate with other organizations and agencies engaged in the furthering of reclamation of lands in the state and make financial contributions to them for such purpose. In carrying out the powers authorized by this chapter, the association of irrigation districts is authorized to enter into contracts with the federal government, the state, irrigation districts, boards of control, municipal or quasi-municipal corporations, cooperatives, other public or private agencies, and associate organizations. The association of irrigation districts is authorized to advance funds to promote the development and utilization of agricultural water and power resources and to employ the technical and professional assistance necessary to survey, plan, investigate, study, print, and publish information and literature to promote the development and utilization of such resources and provide and present data and information to members of congress, any committee of congress, and to other federal officials as an aid in securing needed legislation, contracts, and timely appropriations. CONSTITUTION

Article I

Name

Section 1. The name of this organization shall be the Washington State Water Resources Association, herein referred to as the Association. This Association is engaged in activities authorized by RCW 87 . 76 . 010.

Article II

Purpose

Section 1. The purpose of this Association shall be: to promote responsible stewardship of the water resources of the State of Washington for the benefit of all citizens; to engage in educational and other activities which promote the efficient formation and operation of irrigation districts and irrigation companies; to support the development, control, conservation, preservation and utilization of water resources in a manner which will protect the environment, promote economic growth and add stability to irrigated agriculture and related business; to propose and advocate federal, state and local policies which serve the best interests of the Association and to oppose those of contrary nature; and to work with other water user groups in this and other states and with the National Water Resources Association in the pursuance of common goals.

Article III

Membership

Section 1. Membership in the Association may be held by irrigation districts, irrigation companies, individuals, business firms and other entities interested in assisting in the goals and objectives of the Association.

Section 2. Membership shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Directors of the Association, and current payment of dues or service charges shall be a condition of membership in good standing.

Section 3. Each member in good standing shall be entitled to hold office and to vote at any general membership meeting. For group memberships, each group shall appoint one member to represent their respective organization.

CONSTITUTION

Section 4. Membership in the Association shall also include membership and representation in the National Water Resources Association.

Article IV

General Membership Meetings

Section 1. A general membership meeting shall be held at least once each year at such time and place as selected by the Board of Directors. Special meetings of the general membership shall be called by a majority vote of the Board of Directors. Notice of any general membership meeting shall be mailed to the members at least ten days prior to such meeting. Members present at the annual or special general membership meeting shall constitute a quorum.

Article V

Board of Directors

Section 1. The executive authority of the Association shall be vested in a Board of Directors which shall have the authority to prescribe the duties of all officers in the Association; to establish such committees it shall deem advisable; and to fix the period of their continuance and to prescribe their purposes and objectives. The President of the Association shall be empowered to appoint any member thereof to committees as established by the Board of Directors.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall consist of fifteen (15) members elected at the annual general membership meeting. The term of office shall be three years, provided that for the year following the first annual general membership meeting of this Association there shall be elected five Directors serving a one year term, five for two years, and five for three years; for subsequent years there shall be five positions elected for a three-year term. Eight (8) Directors shall be elected from Director Divisions, as specified in Section 3 of this Article, and seven (7) Directors shall be elected "at large". An "at large" Director may be any Association member in good standing.

CONSTITUTION

Section 3. The State of Washington shall be divided into six (6) Director Divisions as follows:

DIVISION 1 - Pend O'Reille, Spokane, Stevens, and Whitman Counties

DIVISION 2 - Asotin, Columbia, Franklin, Garfield and Walla Walla Counties

DIVISION 3 - Benton, Kittitas, Klickitat, and Yakima Counties

DIVISION 4 - Chelan, Ferry, and Okanogan Counties

DIVISION 5 - Adams, Douglas, Grant, and Lincoln Counties

DIVISION 6 - All counties of the State of Washington

Association Directors from the Director Divisions shall include one each from Divisions 1 through 5 and three from Division 6. A Director elected from a Director Division shall be the irrigation district representative to the Association.

Section 4. The Association Director's term of office shall begin at the close of the annual general membership meeting at which he or she is elected.

Section 5. In case a vacancy shall occur on the Board of Directors, such vacancy shall be filled for the balance of the term by majority vote of the remaining members of the Board.

Section 6. At any Board of Directors meeting, the presence of eight (8) Directors shall constitute a quorum for purposes of transacting business; a majority of whom shall be sufficient to carry any proposition.

CONSTITUTION

Article VI Officers

Section 1. The officers of this Association shall be a President, a Vice President and a National Director for the National Water Resources Association who shall serve for a term of one year following their election by majority vote of the Board of Directors at the first Board meeting following the annual general membership meeting. In case of a vacancy in any officer position such vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the presiding officer and approval of the Directors.

Section 2. All officers of the Association shall be elected from the Board of Directors.

Section 3. An Executive Secretary and Treasurer shall be appointed by the Board of Directors. The President of the Association shall be Chairman of the Board and shall also preside at all general membership meetings.

Article VII Membership Fees

Section 1. Membership fees or service charges in the Association and the schedule of payment thereof shall be established by the Board of Directors.

Article VIII Bylaws

Section 1. Bylaws not inconsistent with the provisions of this Constitution may be adopted by the Board of Directors; such bylaws may be amended only by a majority vote of the Directors, or at any general membership meeting.

Article IX Amendments

Section 1. This Constitution, or any part thereof, may be amended by a majority vote of the members present at a general membership meeting of the Association. Written notice of any proposed amendment shall be given to the membership at least thirty days prior to the date of the general membership meeting.

BY-LAWS

Article I

Section 1. Name. The name of this organization shall be the WASHINGTON STATE WATER RESOURCES ASSOCIATION (hereinafter referred to as the Association).

Section 2. Principal Office. The principal office for the transaction of business of the Association is located at 606 Columbia Street, NW, Suite 211, Olympia, WA 98501.

Section 3. Purposes. The purposes of the Association shall be as set forth in the Constitution.

Article II

Membership and Dues

Section 1. Membership. There shall be three classes of membership as follows:

(a) IRRIGATION DISTRICT MEMBERS. Any irrigation or reclamation district organized under and pursuant to Title 87 or Title 89 of the Revised Code of Washington shall be eligible for Irrigation District Membership.

(b) GENERAL MEMBERS. Any public or private agency, private company or corporation (including irrigation companies), associations or individuals, who's interests are supportive of irrigated agriculture in the State of Washington shall be eligible for General Membership. General Membership shall be divided into the following categories: (i) business, (ii) individual, (iii) irrigation company, (iv) municipal, and (v) federal/state agency.

(c) HONORARY MEMBERS. Any person who has rendered conspicuous service in furthering the purposes of the Association may, by a vote of the Board of Directors, be granted an Honorary Membership in the Association. Honorary members shall be entitled to full membership privileges without payment of dues or assessments. Recipients of the Water Resources Leadership Award shall automatically become Honorary Members at the time the Award is conferred. All Honorary Memberships conferred by the Washington State Reclamation Association or the State Association of Washington Irrigation Districts shall be honored by this Association.

BY-LAWS

Section 2. Dues. Membership dues shall become payable as of January 1 of each year and shall become delinquent as of June 30 of the same year in which they were assessed. Any member (except honorary members) not paying the current year's dues in full by September 30, shall not be considered a member in good standing and shall lose all privileges granted by virtue of membership in the Association. Any member may apply to the Board of Directors for a change in its dues because of conditions which differentiate such applicant from other members. Any unused portion of dues paid by new general members subscribing to membership after June 30th, shall be applied towards payment of the first year of full membership. Any member utilizing exhibit space at the annual meeting shall pay a minimum of \$100.00 membership dues for that year.

Section 3. Annual Membership Meeting. A meeting of the membership shall be held annually at such time and place as the Board of Directors shall determine. Notice of the meeting shall be mailed to each member of the Association not less than 20 days prior to such meeting.

Section 4. Voting. Each member in attendance at the Annual Membership Meeting shall be entitled to vote as provided in the Constitution, except that any elected or appointed official of an irrigation district member in good standing, shall each be entitled to one vote.

BY-LAWS

Article III Officers

Section 1. Duties. The President shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Directors, the Executive Committee, and the general membership. The President shall appoint all committees, including the chairman thereof, and shall perform all other duties necessary to carry out the functions of his office. The President shall be a member of all committees. All committee chairmen shall serve at the pleasure of the President.

The Executive Secretary/Treasurer shall perform the duties assigned by the Board of Directors and shall render a report to the Board of Directors at the first meeting following the close of each calendar year, or as soon thereafter as possible, showing the membership of the Association, the receipts and expenditures during the year, and a resume of the work accomplished. A similar report shall be made at the Annual Membership Meeting. The executive secretary is authorized to perform all financial transactions to further the purposes of the Association, including but not limited to establishing checking and savings accounts; investing funds; borrowing funds and executing contracts as specifically authorized by the board of directors.

Section 2. Bonds. The Board of Directors may require fidelity bonds to be furnished by any officer and/or employee handling the finances of the Association in such amounts as it may deem desirable or necessary, said bond, or bonds, to be approved by the Board of Directors and the premiums therefore to be paid by the Association.

Section 3. Vacancies. The Vice President shall, in the absence of the President assume all of the duties of that office and, if a vacancy occurs, succeed thereto for the unexpired term.

Section 4. Qualifications. All officer and director positions shall be held by elected or appointed officials of any irrigation or reclamation district, any designated representative of a general member, or by any individual general member.

BY-LAWS

Article IV Board of Directors

Section 1. Directors. Directors shall exercise such authority and responsibilities as set forth in the Constitution of the Association.

Section 2. Regular Meetings. Regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall normally be held on the third Wednesday of every other month at a time and location as designated by the Board of Directors or the Executive Committee. Notice of the meeting will be made to each director in writing by first class mail postmarked not later than five (5) days prior to the date of the meeting.

Section 3. Special Meetings. Special meetings may be called by the President or upon written request of twenty (20%) percent of the Board of Directors. Notice of special meetings shall be consistent with the requirements of regular meetings.

Section 4. Agenda Items. The agenda for both regular and special meetings shall be sent with the notice for the meeting. Items not placed on the advance agenda shall require a two thirds majority vote to pass.

Section 5. Quorums. At any meeting of the Board of Directors, representatives of fifty percent (50%) of the Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

Section 6. Attendance. Any director will be disqualified from serving if he or she misses two consecutive regularly scheduled Board meetings or three regularly scheduled Board meetings within a calendar year; provided, the Board of Directors can excuse one or more of the absences if the board, at its sole discretion, determines an absence is for just cause. At the Board Meeting following the meeting at which a director has missed two consecutive regularly scheduled meetings or three regularly scheduled meetings within a calendar year, the Board shall take action to replace said Director in accordance with Article V, Section 5, of the Constitution; or, if requested by said Director, excuse one or more of the Director's absences.

BY-LAWS

Article V

Executive Committee

Section 1. Membership. There shall be an Executive Committee consisting of the following: The President of the Association, who shall be the Chairman thereof; the Vice President; the National Director; the immediate Past President; and two (2) board members selected to at-large positions, who shall be appointed by the full board of directors. The Executive Secretary/Treasurer shall be an ex officio member of the Executive Committee.

Section 2. Powers. The Executive Committee shall exercise those powers necessary to promote the objectives of the Association and shall perform such other duties and assume such other responsibilities as are delegated to it by the Board of Directors.

Section 3. Reporting. The President, or any person designated by him, shall report to the Board of Directors, at any regular or special Board meeting, all action taken by the Executive Committee since the last preceding Board meeting.

Section 4. Meetings. Meetings of the Executive Committee shall be called by the President at such time and place as he deems necessary to transact the affairs of the Association.

Article VI

Standing Committees

Section 1. Administrative Staff Committee. There shall be an Administrative Staff Committee, the purpose of which shall be to provide a forum for the exchange of concepts, problems and mutual assistance among irrigation district managers and staff; and to review matters of administrative procedure affecting irrigation district office procedures. It shall be the duty of this committee to prepare and update an "Irrigation Laws Calendar" of procedures prescribed by law, compile and update examples of forms for inclusion in the Irrigation Laws Handbook, and to undertake such other tasks as directed by the President or Board of Directors.

Section 2. Auditing Committee. There shall be an Auditing Committee which shall perform an internal audit of the Association's financial records. The audit shall be performed as soon as possible following the conclusion of the calendar year and the report presented to the Board of Directors.

BY-LAWS

Section 3. Awards Committee. There shall be an Awards Committee which shall have the responsibility of selecting the most deserving recipient of the Water Resources Leadership Award and nominees for such other awards as the President or Board of Directors may direct.

Section 4. Legal Committee. There shall be a Legal Committee consisting of two or more interested lawyers representing an irrigation district member in good standing, and General Counsel for WSWRA. The chairperson shall be WSWRA General Counsel. It shall be the duty of the committee to process requests for amicus participation in cases of interest to WSWRA members. The Legal Committee shall consider requests and advise the Board of Directors regarding WSWRA participation as an amicus in proceedings authorized by WSWRA policy. The Legal Committee will review legal decisions affecting irrigation district operation, advise the Board of Directors and irrigation district membership on how these decisions will affect irrigation districts in general, and recommend language for possible revision of existing laws.

Section 5. Legislative Committee. There shall be a Legislative Committee, the Chairperson of which shall be the current Association Vice President or other individual selected by the President. Subcommittee chairmen shall be appointed to handle legislation of specific subject matter. The subcommittee chairmen shall compose the Legislative Committee. The Legislative Committee shall recommend the position to be taken by the Association on all legislation significantly impacting irrigation district operations and/or enhance or impair the goals and objectives of Association members.

Section 6. Membership Development Committee. There shall be a Membership Development Committee which shall be charged with the responsibility of promoting membership in the Association.

Section 7. Nominating Committee. The Nominating Committee shall be composed of three (3) active members who are past presidents of the Association or its predecessor organizations. Ordinarily, the committee will be composed of the three (3) most recent past presidents, with the most recent past president serving as chairman. The Nominating Committee will attempt to place into nomination individuals who will provide a broad and balanced geographical representation. The Committee shall also endeavor, to

the extent possible, to have officers terms coincide with that of the Washington State Legislature. The beginning term for officers should be the same as the year of the long session of the Legislature.

Article VII Special Committees

Section 1. Other Committees. Such other committees may be appointed by the President from time to time as need therefore shall dictate.

Article VIII Miscellaneous

Section 1. Political Contribution and Endorsements. The Association shall not make any contributions, nor endorse any candidate for public office. Endorsements of individuals for appointive positions may be considered by the Board, but may be acted on only after placement on the advance agenda.

Section 2. Amendments. These bylaws may be amended at any regular meeting or special meeting of the Board of Directors by majority vote and provided that written notice of the proposed change or changes shall be given in writing not less than 10 days before the meeting at which action is taken.

Section 3. Indemnity. The Association shall indemnify the directors, officers, and employees, made a party to a proceeding because of being a director, officer or employee of the Association, against liability incurred in the proceeding, and shall reimburse the directors', officers' or employees' reasonable expenses in such a proceeding, without regard to the limitations in RCW 23B.08.510 through 23B.08.550, and without the need for any determination as to indemnity or advance of expenses in accordance with RCW 23B.08.550, provided that such indemnity and reimbursement shall not indemnify or reimburse any director, officer or employee from or on account of-

- a) acts or omissions of the director, officer or employee finally adjudged to be intentional misconduct or a knowing violation of law; or
- b) conduct of the director, officer or employee finally adjudged to be in violation of RCW 23B.08.310; or
- c) any transaction with respect to which it is finally adjudged that such director, officer or employee personally received a benefit in money, property, or services to which the director, officer or employee is not legally entitled.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

In order to promote the responsible stewardship of the water resources of the state; to protect irrigated lands for present and future generations; to ensure the continuation of services and the coordination of state and federal agencies dealing with water resources; to aid such agencies in securing prompt authorization, appropriation of funds and completion of projects, and in formulating and implementing water resource policies and procedures; to assist irrigation districts and water users in the economic development and operation of water improvements and the integration of their activities with state and federal agencies; and to preserve the water rights and interests of irrigation districts and irrigation companies; it shall be the objective of the Washington State Water Resources Association to:

- 1 Engage in activities which promote the efficient formation and operation of irrigation districts and irrigation companies in this state - including, but not limited to, promotion of legislation in furtherance of such purposes;
- 2 Promote federal and state legislation for bringing about better planning, use and management of water resources and oppose legislation inconsistent with those purposes;
- 3 Join with other water user groups in comprehensive water resource planning;
- 4 Represent and further the interests of irrigated agriculture in various public and administrative decision making processes involving water resources and related natural resources. Such decision making includes issues such as water rights, water quality standards, fisheries regulations, hydroelectric development, etc.;
- 5 Act as communications conduit for irrigation districts and irrigation companies to collect and disseminate all types of information pertinent to the governing, operation and administration of such districts and companies;
- 6 Inform and educate other interest groups and the public regarding the benefits and economic significance of irrigated agriculture;

STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

- 7 Promote the continuing development and eventual completion of the Columbia Basin Project in a timely manner consistent with the needs of the state and the nation;
- 8 Urge the completion of the Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement Project;
- 9 Support the passage of appropriate state and federal legislation authorizing Phase II of the Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement;
- 10 Support construction of new water storage facilities as an integral part of the Yakima River Basin Water Enhancement Project;
- 11 Support the development and completion of the Palmer lake Water Storage Project to augment irrigation water supplies for the Oroville-Tonasket Irrigation District in water short years; and
- 12 Support state and local agency interaction with the International Joint Commission (IJC) through the Osoyoos Lake Board of Control for enhancing operations and management of Lake Osoyoos water storage for beneficial use for all priority uses.

The foregoing statement, together with the current resolutions, express the objectives of the Washington State Water Resources Association and shall be diligently pursued by its Board of Directors, Officers, Executive Director, general membership and authorized representatives.
